

# Together, let's continue to honor the memory of soldiers of the 1<sup>st</sup> Brigade Genius Special

90 «In Honor Of» panels, spanning the seven coastal communities of Utah Beach have formed a unique memorial and signage system since World War II.

On June 6, 1944, more than 23,000 men, 1,700 vehicles and 1,695 tons of equipment I anded on Utah Beach. The 19,500 men of the 1st Engineer Special Brigade, under Colonel Eugène M. Caffey's command, had an essential mission: to ensure the delivery of the landing's logistics to the beach.

To facilitate the flow of the various transit units along the many coastal and marshy roads, the brigade's signposting teams set up roadside signposts in the early days after the initial landing. But very quickly, Colonel Eugène M. Caffey began to enhance them with simple boards to memorialize 45 of 96 from his unit who fell in the early days of the invasion.

In the autumn of 1944, Colonel Caffey designed commemorative panels, «in Honor Of», to replace the original planks. His personal initiative proved unique not only in Normandy, but all over France.

In 1958, the wooden panels were replaced by the Michelin Group, respecting the original shape and reinforcing it with concrete. The wear and tear of time, however, has weakened these original panels, as well as the resin replicas installed in 1994.



Today, as the D-Day Beaches are once again being considered for recognition on UNESCO's World Heritage List, the D-Day Museum and the coastal communities of Utah Beach need your support to keep remembering these men and Colonel Caffey's commitment to honoring their memory.

The project to renovate the «In Honor of» panels will be implemented over two years (2024 and 2025). It will include an impact campaign with cultural and educational initiatives.
